	Medicaid	Private Insurance
Is telemedicine reimbursed? 	Yes. The provider must bill codes with a 95 modifier and Place of Service code 02.	Yes. Texas has parity law.
Patient location 	Texas does not limit acceptable patient sites. Reimbursement is allowed for services to a patient's home.	
Provider location 	No restrictions	No restrictions

Reimbursement amount 	Provider site payment should be the same as in person The patient site can bill for an originating site or facility fee only for telemedicine providers.	Private insurers' policies can vary; may cover facility fees.
