About Dr. Rakhshanda Layeequr Rahman

Dr. Rahman has an over 15 years of experience working with surgical oncology. She is the founding Director of the multi-campus Breast Center of Excellence established in 2010 at TTUHSC.

She is a professor of surgical oncology research at TTUHSC, and the former Medical Director of UMC Cancer Center in 2019. In 2022, she was selected as a Commission on Cancer (CoC) State Chair for North Texas Chapter. She maintains an active clinical research, educational and leadership portfolio and serves on several local, regional and national boards and committees. Her clinical research interest includes cryoablative therapy for breast cancers, tumor infiltrating lymphocytes, circulatory tumor cells and aromatase related pathways in breast cancer.

Her current leadership research includes the impact of principled centered leadership training on wellbeing. She has led the community collaborative throughout West Texas for prevention of breast, cervical and colorectal cancer and screening and has been funded by the Cancer Prevention and Research Institute of Texas since 2010.
